## Duchy Hospital Exclusions Criteria

- Patients under 18 years of age.
- Any patient who has an unstable mental health condition and is receiving psychiatric treatment.
- Unfortunately, we are unable to undertake surgery on patients who have a significant medical history which would increase their clinic risk. This would include major cardiac problems, neurological disabilities or a BMI above 40. Our BMI limit for hips, knees, foot and ankle, however, is 35. Patients in this category would be more suitable for surgery at RCHT where HDU/ITU/CCU facilities are available.
- Patients with complex blood disorders including haemophilia and sickle cell anaemia.
- However, if you have any queries concerning the suitability of a patient, please feel free to call our Head of Clinical Services, Debby Blease on 01872 226 100 to discuss any health issues you feel might be relevant.
- Any patient that is suitable for St. Michaels, Hayle is normally suitable for us at Duchy Hospital.

# Diagnostic Services Available at **Duchy Hospital**

Our Radiology Department is run by a friendly team of experienced, qualified radiographers. Images are reported by a specialist Consultant Radiologist and sent directly to GP or referring healthcare professional, usually within 48 hours.

Radiology appointments can only be issued to the patient on receipt of a medical referral from the GP.

Any self-pay or insured radiology referrals being made to Duchy Hospital must be signed by the referring GP or healthcare professional. These referrals can be sent via the online referral portal.

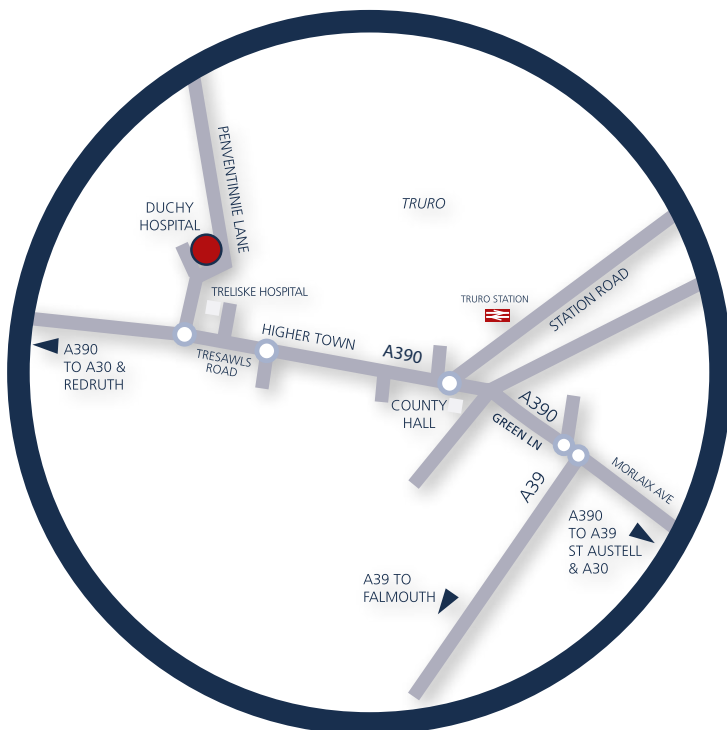
